

Looking through information, contacts, and solutions offered by service providers requires significant time and energy.


People mainly access these through online platforms and people they know and trust. "I was very active in searching out and reaching out to providers of various options."

How **compelling and accessible** is the EA program?


- How many EAs join the program and what demographics they are coming from

- What is the most effective number and ratio of Energy Ambassadors and Transitioned residents to have in a community?

How **successful** is the program in accelerating energy transitions?

- How many homes transition with help from an Energy Ambassador?
- What levels of transition are happening?
- Are there significant decreases in oil sales and usage?
